Is Your Outdated Plumbing Wasting Water and Your Money?

Today, almost every community has a way you can easily recycle products that you use on a daily basis, such as aluminum cans, scrap paper, and glass jars and bottles. These are some great initial steps to help our environment and live in a healthier world. However, there are more things that can be done. In particular, your plumbing system can be incredibly wasteful—right at this very moment it could be wasting tons of water. Not only is that bad for the environment; it's bad for your bank account! Here are some interesting statistics:

- Just one dripping faucet can waste more than 180 gallons of water a month and 2,160 gallons per year!
- Due to inefficient water heaters, people run showers and faucets waiting for the water to get warm. In the process, they waste on average 9,000 gallons of water each year!
- A single leaky toilet can waste tens of thousands of gallons in just one year—enough water to fill a backyard swimming pool! And according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), 20 to 40 percent of ALL toilets leak!

Another interesting fact, in 1994, the National Energy Policy Act was passed. It set standards on all plumbing fixtures forcing them to become more efficient. So, if your home or plumbing fixtures are over 25 years old, it's highly likely that they are drastically behind new, regimented standards. On average, they could be wasting twice as much water than is necessary!

If you want to slow down your water waste, here are a few home improvements you may need to consider:

- **Eliminate leaks and drippy faucets:** A small leak of just one drip per second can cost you several dollars per month. When you consider that many toilets leak, the average homeowner could be losing hundreds of dollars each year.
- **Install new faucets:** New faucets can reduce water waste by as much as 50 percent.
- **Install new showerheads:** Like faucets, outdated showerheads also use more water than necessary. New high-efficiency showerheads can reduce water waste by as much as 60 percent!
- **Install new toilets:** Toilets use 30 percent of every home's water supply making it the single highest indoor consumer. Toilets installed prior to 1994 use twice as much water, and toilets installed before 1980 use almost five times more! A new toilet can save at least 3,400 gallons of water per year.

9 TIPS TO PREVENT HOUSE FIRES AND KEEP YOUR FAMILY SAFE.

October is National Fire Prevention Month, and because this is our Fall issue of our newsletter, we thought there would be no better time to pass along some friendly tips on how you can protect your family from the threat of fire. More than 1.5 million house fires occurred last year, and that number was considered low by many experts.

- 1. Install smoke detectors.** You should add new batteries and inspect them once a year. At least one detector should be added to every level of your home. Detectors are an absolute must.
- 2. Have a safe fire escape method.** Every member of your family should have two ways to escape a room should a fire occur. Sit down with your family to develop the plan, and make sure they all understand how they can evacuate if this potentially hazardous situation occurs. Have a designated meeting place outside, away from the house, that everyone should go to immediately, perhaps your mailbox or a neighbor's porch. You can then determine quickly if anyone is still in the house.
- 3. Test windows and doors.** It's great to have a fire escape plan, but make sure you can execute upon it if the need arises. Make sure windows and doors are easily opened.
- 4. Don't call emergency services until you're out of your home.** Have any emergency numbers in a cell phone or written down in a wallet. Once all family members have evacuated the burning home, then make the call. Every second is critical should a fire start.
- 5. Give space heaters space.** If you absolutely must use a space heater, nothing should be within three feet of it. And never leave space heaters on when you leave home or go to bed. They are serious fire hazards.
- 6. Be careful if you're a smoker.** Misplaced cigarettes and cigars are among the leading reasons for home fires. If you still smoke in your home, never do so while sleepy, and never discard hot butts in the trash can.
- 7. Be careful when cooking.** Keep your cooking area clean of any potential combustibles. Wear short sleeves when you cook. All pots and pan handles should face inward, so no one can accidentally knock one off the stove. If you ever experience a grease fire, carefully slide a lid over the pan, smother the fire, and turn off the burner.
- 8. Matches, lighters, and candles are dangerous.** Children should never handle any of these. Teach any kids in your household that they are adult tools and not toys. Then, make sure that these tools are stored where little hands can't grab them.
- 9. Practice electrical safety.** If an appliance smokes or has an unusual smell, unplug it and have it looked at by a professional. Replace any cords that are cracked or tattered, and don't overload extension cords. Both are severe fire hazards.

RECIPES

Goat Cheese Crab

Dip

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 shallot, finely chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 1 cup half-and-half
- 8 ounces reduced-fat cream cheese, cubed, at room temperature
- 8 ounces grated goat cheese
- 1 pound claw crabmeat, picked through for shells and cartilage
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
- 1/4 cup panko breadcrumbs
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- Whole-wheat pita chips, for serving



Preparation

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.
2. Melt the butter over medium-high heat in a large skillet. Once foaming, add the shallots and cook until softened, 3 to 4 minutes. Add the garlic and cook until fragrant, 1 minute. Add the half-and-half and bring to a simmer. Whisk in the cream cheese in increments. Once incorporated and smooth, add all but 1/4 cup of the goat cheese in handfuls and whisk until melted. Remove from the heat and stir in the crabmeat and 2 tablespoons of the chopped parsley. Pour into a 1 1/2-quart casserole dish.
3. Mix together the panko, remaining 1/4 cup grated cheese, remaining 2 tablespoons parsley and the paprika in a small bowl. Sprinkle the top of the dip with the mixture. Bake until bubbly and hot, 20 minutes. Serve with whole wheat pita chips.
